OBJECTION TO COUNSEL'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO WITHDRAW

Comes now **Wayland Braxton Willis**, and respectfully files this Objection to the Notice of Intent to Withdraw filed by counsel of record, **Holly G. Chapman**, and shows this Court as follows:


1. I am currently involved in an active and urgent custody matter involving visitation issues, communication concerns, and ongoing involvement of the Guardian ad Litem.
2. Counsel's withdrawal at this stage would cause a **significant delay** in resolving these pending matters and would leave me unrepresented during a critical phase of the case.
3. I do not have alternate counsel retained, and securing new representation immediately would not be possible without causing substantial interruption to the progress of the case.
4. Allowing withdrawal at this time would cause **prejudice to my rights as a parent** and negatively affect the ongoing issues regarding my time with my child.
5. It is in the best interest of the minor child, and justice, for counsel to remain on the case until pending matters are addressed or until replacement counsel can be secured without prejudice.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully ask this Court to:

- (a) **Deny** the Notice of Intent to Withdraw filed by Ms. Chapman; and
- (b) Require counsel to remain on the case until pending matters have been addressed or

until replacement counsel can be secured without prejudice to my parenting time or rights.
