THIRD TEMPORARY ORDER

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Plaintiff's' Complaint for Modification of Visitation and Child Support and for Emergency *Ex Parte* Relief. A temporary hearing was scheduled on December 9, 2025. Plaintiff was present and represented by her counsel of record, Adam D. Land. Defendant was also present and elected to proceed *Pro Se*. Now upon consideration of the sworn pleadings of the parties, all evidence presented (including the testimony of the Guardian Ad Litem, Renee Bell), and the argument and proffer of counsel, the Court hereby **FINDS** that the entry of the instant Third Temporary Order is necessary and appropriate under the circumstances of this case.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff shall continue to have primary physical custody of the parties' minor child, to wit: Wayland Brooks Willis, born in 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant's visitation with the

minor child shall remain suspended unless and until (1) he takes a negative 17 panel hair follicle drug screen and a PEth test by no later than December 9, 2025 at 4:00 PM (See separate Drug Testing Order); and (2) the results of said tests are negative for all substances and alcohol; and (3) he completes the Clinical Evaluation that was previously ordered by the Court. If the Defendant meets all of the above conditions, then he may have supervised daytime visits with the minor child as follows:

- December 17, 2025 - From 4:00 PM until 7:00 PM
- December 24, 2025 - From 1:00 PM until 8:00 PM
- December 25, 2025 - From 1:00 PM until 7:00 PM
- December 27, 2025 - From 3:00 PM until 8:00 PM
- December 28, 2025 - From 12:00 PM until 6:00 PM
- December 31, 2025 - From 4:00 PM until 7:00 PM
- January 3, 2026 - From 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM
- January 10, 2026 - From 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM
- January 17, 2026 - From 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM
- January 24, 2026 - From 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM
- January 31, 2026 - From 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM

(For all periods of visitation in January 2026, the Defendant may change his day of visitation to Sunday if his parents are unavailable to supervise.)

Beginning in February 2026, the Guardian Ad Litem shall have the authority to set the visitation schedule with alternating

weekend (Saturday or Sunday) daytime visitation being the preferred arrangement. If either party has a dispute with the Guardian's schedule, they may schedule a hearing with the Court.

All periods of visitation shall be supervised by the paternal grandparents of the minor child unless the parties agree on an alternative supervisor. For the purpose of this Order, supervised visitation means that the supervisor shall have eyes on the minor child at all times during visitation and shall transport the minor child at the beginning of visitation, during visitation and at the conclusion of visitation. Under no circumstances shall the minor child be left alone with the Defendant for any period of time during visitation. The Defendant is specifically prohibited from driving the minor child.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Guardian Ad Litem shall perform periodic drop ins during the Defendant's visitation to confirm that the rules for supervision are being followed. Additionally, the Guardian Ad Litem shall have the authority to drug test (hair follicle and/or urine) the Defendant at any time and may request that any other individual who will be around the minor child also submit to random drug screens.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there shall be no contact between the minor child and Sara Berry.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant shall undergo a

psychological evaluation with Dr. Amy Holsten. A separate Order for Psychological Evaluation has been entered contemporaneously herewith.


All other matters are reserved until further Order of the Court.
