**DEFENDANT’S MOTION TO ENFORCE EFFECT OF NON-ACTION AND FOR  
DECLARATORY RELIEF REGARDING CONTINUED RESTRICTIONS**

Defendant has filed multiple motions requesting clarification of authority, written findings, and enforcement of lawful process governing restrictions upon Defendant’s parental rights. Those motions remain pending.

As of the filing of the present Motion, no written findings of fact, conclusions of law, or express identification of authority have been entered authorizing the continued restriction or deprivation of Defendant’s parental rights.

Parental rights may be restricted only pursuant to adjudication or express written authority identifying the factual and legal basis for such restriction.

Where no such findings or authority are entered, continued restriction lacks identifiable legal footing and cannot be treated as implicit authorization, delegated discretion, or administrative default.

This Motion does not seek reconsideration of any prior ruling and does not re-litigate any factual allegation. It addresses only the present operative status of authority reflected on the record.

Any discretion exercised by a Guardian ad Litem must be grounded in written judicial definition identifying scope and limits.

In the absence of such definition, no discretionary authority may be inferred to permit continued restriction or deprivation of parental rights.

Defendant respectfully requests entry of an order:

1. Declaring that any restriction, directive, or limitation affecting Defendant's parental rights must be grounded in an express written order identifying factual findings and legal authority;
2. Declaring that continued restriction or deprivation of Defendant's parental rights absent such written authority is unenforceable;
3. Clarifying that no interim, conditional, or review-contemplating order may be construed to authorize indefinite restriction absent express written findings;
4. Preserving and incorporating by reference all relief requested in Defendant's pending Motion for Enforcement, Sanctions, and Written Findings.

Defendant requests entry of findings sufficient to permit meaningful appellate or supervisory review of continued restriction or non-enforcement.

Defendant seeks no relief beyond clarification and enforcement of the requirement that restrictions upon parental rights be grounded in identifiable judicial authority. This Motion is submitted solely to address the present status of the record.


