I, Wayland Braxton Willis, being duly sworn, declare as follows:


1. I am the Defendant in this matter. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein and am competent to testify to them.
2. This declaration is submitted for the limited purpose of authenticating and defining the parent-child communication logs attached as Exhibits 3 and 4, covering the period from October 2025 through January 2026.
3. During the period reflected in Exhibits 3 and 4, I repeatedly attempted to communicate with my minor child through available and appropriate means, including telephone and electronic communication.
4. Each entry in the communication logs reflects the status of parent-child communication on or about the date listed, including whether communication was available, restricted, or did not occur, and the resulting outcome.
5. Entries marked as successful or normal reflect communications that occurred.
6. Entries marked as delayed, restricted, or no contact reflect instances in which communication did not occur due to denial, non-response, or obstruction not caused by any failure or inaction on my part.
7. No court order entered in this matter suspends, prohibits, or conditions parent-child communication during the period

reflected in Exhibits 2 and 2a.

8. The communication logs do not reflect intent, motive, or interpretation. They reflect only attempted contact and the resulting outcome.
9. The totals reflected in the communication logs are approximate and are provided to show overall patterns and duration, not precise counts.
10. Exhibits 3 and 4 are true and accurate records reflecting my parent-child communication availability and the resulting outcomes during the periods shown."
