SUPPLEMENTAL AFFIDAVIT OF INDIGENCY
AND RESPONSE TO ORDER OF MARCH 17, 2026

COMES NOW Petitioner Wayland Braxton Willis, pro se, and pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 9-15-2, respectfully files this Supplemental Affidavit of Indigency in response to this Court's Order of March 17, 2026, and states as follows:

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT REGARDING MARCH 17, 2026 ORDER

This Court's Order of March 17, 2026 states that "nor has a financial affidavit been filed." Petitioner respectfully notes that an Affidavit of Indigency was filed on March 13, 2026 as a separate docket entry in this action via PeachCourt, accepted and confirmed by PeachCourt Notification (Peach No. E-RCPX4V4L), and reflected in the docket record as Entry 6. Additionally, the Georgia Court of Appeals accepted Petitioner's Affidavit of Indigency in Case No. A26E0154 — which referenced the December 9, 2025 non-ruling in 2025EDR0053 — prior to that petition's denial on jurisdictional grounds on March 6, 2026. To the extent the March 13 affidavit was insufficient in financial detail, Petitioner submits this Supplemental Affidavit providing complete financial information as requested.

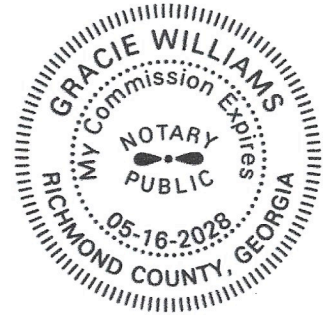
